So easy to get to

RAIL

Falmer station, a few minutes' walk from the stadium, is on the Brighton-Lewes-Eastbourne line. Trains from Brighton station take eight minutes.

BUS

The main services between the University of Brighton in Village Way and the city centre are 5B, 23, 84 and 25, the last of which runs every 10 minutes.

Services 28, 29 and 29a run to and from the east along the A27, stopping either side of the road near Falmer station.

ROAD

The stadium is alongside the A27, three miles east of its junction with the A23 London-Brighton road.

Whether coming from east or west, turn off the A27 at the Falmer/Rottingdean junction next to the universities. Take the B2123 signposted Rottingdean, turning right into Village Way after 200m.
